TERMINOLOGY AND ABBREVIATIONS

COOKIE BOX PATTERNS ADHERE TO US CROCHET TERMINOLOGY:

SC: SINGLE CROCHET

INC: INCREASE

DEC: DECREASE

SL ST: SLIP STITCH

CH: CHAIN

HDC: HALF DOUBLE CROCHET

DC: DOUBLE CROCHET

This project is crocheted in continuous rounds, and we use «row» and «round» interchangeably.

READING THE PATTERN

ROW 4: [2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)

ROUND 4

indicates the row or round number

[2 SC, INC]

a sequence consisting of 2 single crochet stitches followed by an increase

X 6

the amount of times you need to repeat the sequence in the row or round

(24)

the total number of stitches you should have when you finish the row or round.

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DEPENDING ON THE PIECE YOU'RE WORKING ON, YOU WILL NEED TO USE ONE OF THESE METHODS TO FINISH IT OFF:

♥ **Invisible Fasten-Off:**

Pull the yarn tail through the last stitch. Use a tapestry needle to thread the tail, then pass it under the stitch after the next one. Guide the needle between the "V" of the stitch you just came from, from top to bottom, and out the other side. Pull the tail so the new stitch matches the others in size. Lastly, weave the needle under the nearby horizontal bar for added security.

♥ **Fasten-off:**

Slide the needle under the front loop of each of the six stitches, one by one, from the inside to the outside, then pull on the yarn tail to tighten the hole in the middle. Hide the yarn tail and cut off the excess yarn.

♥ **Crochet Edges Together:**

Join the sides together. Align the first and last stitches of the round. Insert your hook through both stitches and make a single crochet stitch. Continue crocheting through both sides of the round. If it's easier, start with the first and second-to-last stitches instead.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

TO COMPLETE YOUR PLUSHIE, YOU WILL NEED TO USE THE FOLLOWING SEWING TECHNIQUES:

- ♥ Attach one 3D piece to another 3D piece.
- ♥ Join a flat piece to another flat piece.
- ♥ Attach a flat piece onto a 3D piece.

HEAD AND BODY

With dark brown yarn

Magic ring

ROUND 1:	6 SC (6)
ROUND 2:	6 INC (12)
ROUND 3:	[SC, INC] X 6 (18)
ROUND 4:	[2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)
ROUND 5:	[3 SC, INC] X 6 (30)
ROUND 6:	[4 SC, INC] X 6 (36)
ROUND 7-10:	36 SC (36)
ROUND 11:	[4 SC, DEC] X 6 (30)
ROUND 12:	[3 SC, DEC] X 6 (24)

Insert the eyes between Round 6-7, 5 stitches apart.

Add Stuffing

ROUND 13:	[2 SC, DEC] X 6 (18)
ROUND 14:	[SC, DEC] X 6 (12)
ROUND 15:	[SC, INC] X 6 (18)
ROUND 16:	18 SC (18)
ROUND 17:	[2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)
ROUND 18:	24 SC (24)
ROUND 19:	[3 SC, INC] X 6 (30)
ROUND 20:	30 SC (30)
ROUND 21:	[3 SC, DEC] X 6 (24)
ROUND 22:	[2 SC, DEC] X 6 (18)

Stuff the head and body completely.

ROUND 23:	[SC, DEC] X 6 (12)
ROUND 24:	6 DEC (6)

♥ Fasten off.

ARMS

With dark brown yarn

Magic ring

- ROUND 1:** 6 SC (6)
ROUND 2: [SC, INC] X 3 (9)
ROUND 3: 9 SC (9)
ROUND 4: [SC, DEC] X 3 (6)
ROUND 5: 6 SC (6)

♥ To fasten off, join the sides together.

LEGS

With dark brown yarn

Magic ring

- ROUND 1:** 6 SC (6)
ROUND 2: 6 INC (12)
ROUND 3: 12 SC (12)

Stuff the leg slightly.

- ROUND 4:** [SC, DEC] X 4 (8)
ROUND 5: 8 SC (8)

♥ To fasten off, join the sides together.

EARS

With dark brown yarn

Magic ring

- ROW 1:** 6 SC (6)
CH 1. TURN

- ROW 2:** [SC, INC] X 3 (9)

♥ Chain stitch to fasten off. Cut a 3-inch yarn tail. Pull the yarn tail through the last stitch completely.

MUZZLE

With light brown yarn

Magic ring

- ROUND 1:** 6 SC (6)
ROUND 2: [SC, INC] X 3 (9)
ROUND 3: 9 SC (9)

♥ Invisible Fasten-Off.

BELLY

With light brown yarn

Magic ring

- ROUND 1:** 6 SC (6)
ROUND 2: 6 INC (12)

♥ Invisible Fasten-Off.

TAIL

With light brown yarn

Magic ring

- ROUND 1:** 6 SC (6)
ROUND 2: [SC, INC] X 3 (9)
ROUND 3: [SC, DEC] X 3 (6)

♥ Invisible Fasten-Off.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1 Attach the ears to the head between rounds 2-6.
- 2 Attach the muzzle to the face between rounds 8-11. Add the nose using brown yarn.
- 3 Attach the arms to the body between rounds 14-17.
- 4 Attach the legs to the bottom of the body between rounds 20-21.
- 5 Attach the tail to the bottom of the body at the spot where it helps the plushie sit best.
- 6 Attach the belly to the body.
