TERMINOLOGY AND ABBREVIATIONS

COOKIE BOX PATTERNS ADHERE TO US CROCHET TERMINOLOGY:

SC: SINGLE CROCHET Th INC: INCREASE In C DEC: DECREASE We SL ST: SLIP STITCH CH: CHAIN HDC: HALF DOUBLE CROCHET DC: DOUBLE CROCHET

This project is crocheted in continuous rounds, and we use «row» and «round» interchangeably.

READING THE PATTERN

ROW 4: [2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)

ROUND 4




indicates the row or round number

a sequence consisting of 2 single crochet stitches followed by an increase

X 6	

the amount of times you need to repeat the sequence in the row or round



the total number of stitches you should have when you finish the row or round. <u>back to contents</u>



DEPENDING ON THE PIECE YOU'RE WORKING ON, YOU WILL NEED TO USE ONE OF THESE METHODS TO FINISH IT OFF:

🔰 Invisible Fasten-Off:

Pull the yarn tail through the last stitch. Use a tapestry needle to thread the tail, then pass it under the stitch after the next one. Guide the needle between the "V" of the stitch you just came from, from top to bottom, and out the other side. Pull the tail so the new stitch matches the others in size. Lastly, weave the needle under the nearby horizontal bar for added security.

Fasten-off:

Slide the needle under the front loop of each of the six stitches, one by one, from the inside to the outside, then pull on the yarn tail to tighten the hole in the middle. Hide the yarn tail and cut off the excess yarn.

Crochet Edges Together:

Join the sides together. Align the first and last stitches of the round. Insert your hook through both stitches and make a single crochet stitch. Continue crocheting through both sides of the round. If it's easier, start with the first and second-to-last stitches instead.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

TO COMPLETE YOUR PLUSHIE, YOU WILL NEED TO USE THE FOLLOWING SEWING TECHNIQUES:

- Attach one 3D piece to another 3D piece.
- Join a flat piece to another flat piece.
- Attach a flat piece onto a 3D piece.

HEAD AND BODY

With light brown yarn Magic ring

ROUND 1:	6 SC (6)
ROUND 2:	6 INC (12)
ROUND 3:	[SC, INC] X 6 (18)
ROUND 4:	[2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)
ROUND 5:	[3 SC, INC] X 6 (30)
ROUND 6:	[4 SC, INC] X 6 (36)
ROUND 7-10:	36 SC (36)
ROUND 11:	[4 SC, DEC] X 6 (30)
ROUND 12:	[3 SC, DEC] X 6 (24)

Insert the eyes between Round 7-8, 5 stitches apart. Add Stuffing

ROUND 13:	[2 SC, DEC] X 6 (18)
ROUND 14:	[SC, DEC] X 6 (12)
ROUND 15:	[SC, INC] X 6 (18)
ROUND 16:	18 SC (18)
ROUND 17:	[2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)
ROUND 18:	24 SC (24)
ROUND 19:	[3 SC, INC] X 6 (30)
ROUND 20:	30 SC (30)
ROUND 21:	[3 SC, DEC] X 6 (24)
ROUND 22:	[2 SC, DEC] X 6 (18)

Stuff the head and body completely.

ROUND 23:	[SC, DEC] X 6 (12)
ROUND 24:	6 DEC (6)

Fasten off.



With white yarn Magic ring

ROUND 1:	6 SC (6)
ROUND 2:	6 INC (12)
ROUND 3:	[SC, DEC] X 4 (8)

🖡 Invisible Fasten-Off.



With light brown yarn. Make two. Magic ring

6 SC (6)
[SC, INC] X 3 (9)
9 SC (9)
[SC, DEC] X 3 (6)
6 SC (6)

To fasten off, join the sides together.



With light brown yarn. Make two. Magic ring

ROUND 1:	6 SC (6)
ROUND 2:	6 INC (12)
ROUND 3-4:	12 SC (12)

Stuff the leg slightly.

ROUND 5:	[SC, DEC] X 4 (8)
ROUND 6:	8 SC (8)

To fasten off, join the sides together.



With light brown yarn. Make two. Magic ring

ROW 1:	6 SC (6)
CH 1, TURN	
ROW 2:	[SC, INC] X 3 (9)
CH 1, TURN	
ROW 3:	9 SC (9)

Chain stitch to fasten off.



With white yarn. Magic ring

ROUND 1: ROUND 2: ROUND 3:

6 SC (6) [INC, 2SC] X 2 (8) [2 INC, 2SC] X 2 (12)

Invisible Fasten-Off.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1 Attach the ears to the head, between rounds 2-6.
- **2** Attach the muzzle to the face just below the eyes, between rounds 8-12, centered according to the eyes. Add the nose using light brown yarn.
- **3** Attach the arms to the body, between rounds 14-17.
- **4** Attach the legs to the bottom of the body, between rounds 20-21. Attach them to the body with an additional stitch for a seated position.
- **5** Attach the tail to the back of the body at the spot where it helps the plushie sit best.

HEART LOBES

With red yarn. Make two. Magic ring

ROUND 1:	6 SC (6)
ROUND 2:	6 INC (12)
ROUND 3:	12 SC (12)

For the first lobe, complete this round and finish with an invisible fasten-off.

For the second lobe, complete Round 3 but do not cut the yarn. This yarn will be used to join the lobes in the next round.

JOIN THE LOBES

ROUND 4:

24 SC (24)

With the second lobe (where the yarn is still attached), keep the hook in the same position as after completing the last stitch.

Begin joining by inserting your hook into any stitch of the first lobe (the one with the invisible fasten-off) and perform a sc. This is the first stitch of Round 4, mark it as the beginning of the round.

Continue to crochet around the rim of both lobes, working through each stitch on each lobe, completing a total of 24 sc to join them.

ROUND 5:	[2 sc, dec] x 6 (18)
ROUND 6:	18 sc (18)

Add stuffing at this point.

ROUND 7:	[SC, DEC] X 6 (12)
ROUND 8:	6 DEC (6)

Fasten off.
