

#### **TERMINOLOGY AND ABBREVIATIONS**

# COOKIE BOX PATTERNS ADHERE TO US CROCHET TERMINOLOGY:

SC: SINGLE CROCHET

INC: INCREASE DEC: DECREASE

SL ST: SLIP STITCH

CH: CHAIN

**HDC:** HALF DOUBLE CROCHET

DC: DOUBLE CROCHET


This project is crocheted in continuous rounds, and we use «row» and «round» interchangeably.

#### READING THE PATTERN


ROW 4: [2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)

indicates the row or round number

a sequence consisting of 2 single crochet stitches followed by an increase

#### FINISHING CROCHET PIECES



DEPENDING ON THE PIECE YOU'RE WORKING ON, YOU WILL NEED TO USE ONE OF THESE METHODS TO FINISH IT OFF:

#### Invisible Fasten-Off:

Pull the yarn tail through the last stitch. Use a tapestry needle to thread the tail, then pass it under the stitch after the next one. Guide the needle between the "V" of the stitch you just came from, from top to bottom, and out the other side. Pull the tail so the new stitch matches the others in size. Lastly, weave the needle under the nearby horizontal bar for added security.

#### Fasten-off:

Slide the needle under the front loop of each of the six stitches, one by one, from the inside to the outside, then pull on the yarn tail to tighten the hole in the middle. Hide the yarn tail and cut off the excess yarn.

#### Crochet Edges Together:

Join the sides together. Align the first and last stitches of the round. Insert your hook through both stitches and make a single crochet stitch. Continue crocheting through both sides of the round. If it's easier, start with the first and second-to-last stitches instead.

#### **SEWING TECHNIQUES**

TO COMPLETE YOUR PLUSHIE, YOU WILL NEED TO USE THE FOLLOWING SEWING TECHNIQUES:

- Attach one 3D piece to another 3D piece.
- Join a flat piece to another flat piece.
- Attach a flat piece onto a 3D piece.

## **HEAD AND BODY**

With light gray yarn Magic ring

**ROW 1:** 6 SC (6) **ROW 2:** 6 INC (12)

ROW 3: [SC, INC] X 6 (18) ROW 4: [2 SC, INC] X 6 (24) ROW 5: [3 SC, INC] X 6 (30)

**ROW 6:** 30 SC (30)

**ROW 7:** [4 SC, INC] X 6 (36)

**ROW 8:** 36 SC (36)

**ROW 9:** [4 SC, DEC] X 6 (30)

**ROW 10:** 30 SC (30)

**ROW 11:** [3 SC, DEC] X 6 (24)

**ROW 12:** 12 DEC (12)

Insert the eyes between Round 6-7, 6 stitches apart. Add Stuffing

**ROW 13:** [SC, INC] X 6 (18)

**ROW 14:** 18 SC (18)

**ROW 15:** [2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)

**ROW 16:** 24 SC (24)

**ROW 17:** [6 SC, DEC] X 3 (21)

**ROW 18:** 21 SC (21)

**ROW 19:** [5 SC, DEC] X 3 (18)

Stuff the head and body completely.

**ROW 20:** [SC, DEC] X 6 (12)

**ROW 21:** 6 DEC (6)

Fasten off.

# **LEGS**

With light gray yarn. Make two.

Magic ring

**ROW 1:** 6 SC (6)

**ROW 2:** 6 INC (12) **ROW 3:** 12 SC (12)

**ROW 4:** [SC, DEC] X 4 (8)

**ROW 5:** 8 SC (8)

Crochet the edges together to close the piece.

#### **ARMS**

With light gray yarn. Make two.

Magic ring

**ROW 1:** 4 SC (4) **ROW 2:** 4 INC (8) **ROW 3-5:** 8 SC (8)

**ROW 6:** [2 SC, DEC] X 2 (6)

Crochet the edges together to close the piece.

## **EARS**

With light gray yarn or white yarn.

Repeat the process to make 2 light gray pieces and 2 white pieces.

Magic ring

**ROW 1:** 6 SC (6) **ROW 2:** 6 INC (12)

**ROW 3:** [SC, INC] X 6 (18)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail of 6-10 inches. Invisible Fasten-Off.

## **BELLY**

With white yarn Magic ring

**ROW 1:** 6 SC (6) **ROW 2:** 6 INC (12)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail of 10-12 inches. Invisible Fasten-Off.



With white yarn Magic ring

**ROW 1:** 6 SC (6) **ROW 2:** 6 SC (6)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail of 6-10 inches. Invisible Fasten-Off.

#### **MUZZLE**

With dark gray yarn Magic ring

**ROW 1:** 4 SC (4)

**ROW 2:** [INC, SC] X 2 (6)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail of 6-10 inches. Invisible Fasten-Off.

#### **SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- **1** Sew the arms to the sides of the body, between rows 12-14
- **2** Sew the legs to the bottom of the body, attach them to the body with an aditional stitch for a seated position.
- **3** Sew the belly to the front of the body closer to the neckline.
- **4** Sew the ear pieces to make the ears. Start by sewing together a light gray part and a white part, keeping the wrong sides of both parts inside, repeat to complete both ears. Then sew the ears to the sides of the head, between rounds 5-8.
- **5** Sew the tail to the back of the body, between rounds 17 -20
- 6 Sew the muzzle onto the face, between Rounds 7 11
