TERMINOLOGY AND ABBREVIATIONS

COOKIE BOX PATTERNS ADHERE TO US CROCHET TERMINOLOGY:

SC: SINGLE CROCHET Th INC: INCREASE OEC: DECREASE We SL ST: SLIP STITCH CH: CHAIN HDC: HALF DOUBLE CROCHET DC: DOUBLE CROCHET

This project is crocheted in continuous rounds, and we use «row» and «round» interchangeably.

READING THE PATTERN


ROW 4: [2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)

ROUND 4


[2 SC, INC]

indicates the row or round number

a sequence consisting of 2 single crochet stitches followed by an increase



the amount of times you need to repeat the sequence in the row or round



the total number of stitches you should have when you finish the row or round. back to contents %



DEPENDING ON THE PIECE YOU'RE WORKING ON, YOU WILL NEED TO USE ONE OF THESE METHODS TO FINISH IT OFF:

┥ Invisible Fasten-Off:

Pull the yarn tail through the last stitch. Use a tapestry needle to thread the tail, then pass it under the stitch after the next one. Guide the needle between the "V" of the stitch you just came from, from top to bottom, and out the other side. Pull the tail so the new stitch matches the others in size. Lastly, weave the needle under the nearby horizontal bar for added security.

Fasten-off:

Slide the needle under the front loop of each of the six stitches, one by one, from the inside to the outside, then pull on the yarn tail to tighten the hole in the middle. Hide the yarn tail and cut off the excess yarn.

Crochet Edges Together:

Join the sides together. Align the first and last stitches of the round. Insert your hook through both stitches and make a single crochet stitch. Continue crocheting through both sides of the round. If it's easier, start with the first and second-to-last stitches instead.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

TO COMPLETE YOUR PLUSHIE, YOU WILL NEED TO USE THE FOLLOWING SEWING TECHNIQUES:

- Attach one 3D piece to another 3D piece.
- Join a flat piece to another flat piece.
- Attach a flat piece onto a 3D piece.

HEAD AND BODY

With green yarn Magic ring

ROW 17:	[2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)	
ROW 18:	24 SC (24)	
ROW 19:	[3 SC, INC] X 6 (30)	
ROW 20:	30 SC (30)	
ROW 21:	[3 SC, DEC] X 6 (24)	
Stuff the head and body completely.

SHELL

Outer part: With brown yarn

ROW 1:	6 SC (6)
ROW 2:	6 INC (12)
ROW 3:	[SC, INC] X 6 (18)
ROW 4:	[2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)
ROW 5:	24 SC (24)
ROW 6:	24 SC (24) FRONT LOOP ONLY (FLO)

Inner part:	

With brown yarn

ROW 1:	6 SC (6)
ROW 2:	6 INC (12)
ROW 3:	[SC, INC] X 6 (18)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail of 6-10 inches. Invisible Fasten-Off.

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With light brown yarn Magic ring

ROW 1:	6 SC (6)
ROW 2:	6 INC (12)
ROW 3:	[SC, INC] X 6 (18)

Cut the yarn, leaving a tail of 20 inches. Invisible Fasten-Off.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

- **1** Place the arms between rows 14-17 at a slight angle.
- **2** Attach the legs between rows 18-22. Sew them to closely to the sides of the body.
- **3** Attach the belly piece to the front using the yarn tail from the magic ring. Attach the shell piece to the back of the body the same way.
- **4** Use the remaining yarn end from the belly to create backpack-style straps: these should go over the shoulders and between the legs.

DECORATION INSTRUCTIONS:

For the Mouth:

- Thread a needle with a 5-inch strand of brown yarn.
- Insert the needle at the mouth's starting point, bringing it out at the end point.
- Tie the yarn ends together twice, being careful not to tighten the stitch excessively. Trim off the excess yarn.
- Tuck the knot inside the head and adjust the mouth's stitch for proper shape.

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For the eye spots:

- Thread the needle with a 10-inch strand of light brown yarn.
- Push the needle through the head, emerging 2 stitches away from the eye and one row above.
- Form a horizontal bar by threading the needle into the next stitch.
- Create two additional spots over the next two rows, placing the second spot one stitch further from the eye than the first and third spots.
- Finish by drawing the needle out at the same point as the other end of the yarn.

Remember to weave all yarn ends into the toy's body for a clean finish.
