TERMINOLOGY AND ABBREVIATIONS

COOKIE BOX PATTERNS ADHERE TO US CROCHET TERMINOLOGY:

SC: SINGLE CROCHET Th INC: INCREASE In C DEC: DECREASE We SL ST: SLIP STITCH CH: CHAIN HDC: HALF DOUBLE CROCHET DC: DOUBLE CROCHET

This project is crocheted in continuous rounds, and we use «row» and «round» interchangeably.

READING THE PATTERN

ROW 4: [2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)

ROUND 4




indicates the row or round number

a sequence consisting of 2 single crochet stitches followed by an increase

X 6	

the amount of times you need to repeat the sequence in the row or round



the total number of stitches you should have when you finish the row or round. <u>back to contents</u>



DEPENDING ON THE PIECE YOU'RE WORKING ON, YOU WILL NEED TO USE ONE OF THESE METHODS TO FINISH IT OFF:

┥ Invisible Fasten-Off:

Pull the yarn tail through the last stitch. Use a tapestry needle to thread the tail, then pass it under the stitch after the next one. Guide the needle between the "V" of the stitch you just came from, from top to bottom, and out the other side. Pull the tail so the new stitch matches the others in size. Lastly, weave the needle under the nearby horizontal bar for added security.

Fasten-off:

Slide the needle under the front loop of each of the six stitches, one by one, from the inside to the outside, then pull on the yarn tail to tighten the hole in the middle. Hide the yarn tail and cut off the excess yarn.

Crochet Edges Together:

Join the sides together. Align the first and last stitches of the round. Insert your hook through both stitches and make a single crochet stitch. Continue crocheting through both sides of the round. If it's easier, start with the first and second-to-last stitches instead.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

TO COMPLETE YOUR PLUSHIE, YOU WILL NEED TO USE THE FOLLOWING SEWING TECHNIQUES:

- Attach one 3D piece to another 3D piece.
- Join a flat piece to another flat piece.
- Attach a flat piece onto a 3D piece.



HEAD - TOP PART:

With pink yarn Magic ring

ROUND 1:	6 SC (6)
ROUND 2:	6 INC (12)
ROUND 3:	[SC, INC] X 6 (18)
ROUND 4:	[2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)
ROUND 5:	[3 SC, INC] X 6 (30)
ROUND 6	[4 SC, INC] X 6 (36)
ROUND 7	[5 SC, INC] X 6 (42)
ROUND 8:	[6 SC, INC] X 6 (48)
ROUND 9-10:	48 SC (48)
ROUND 11:	[6 SC, DEC] X 6 (42)
ROUND 12-14:	42 SC (42)

Insert the eyes between rounds 7-8, 7 stitches apart.

Add Ruffle Edging

Make a slip knot with a new strand of purple yarn. Attach this purple yarn to any stitch using only the front loop, by making a chain stitch.

ROUND 15: crochet 2 hdc into each of the 42 stitches along the edge using the front loop only (FLO) (84)

Fasten off.

HEAD - BOTTOM PART:

With pink yarn Magic ring

Fasten-off.

THIN TENTACLE

Make 3-5 such tentacles in different colors. Slip knot

ROW 1:	26 CH
ROW 2:	25 SL ST

Cut a 2-3 inch yarn tail.

THICK TENTACLE

Make 3-5 such tentacles in different colors. Slip knot

ROW	1:	26 CH
ROW	2:	25 SC

Cut a 2-3 inch yarn tail.

DECORATIVE BAND

With hot pink yarn.

Start with a slip knot. Create a chain of approximately 42 ch. Adjust the number of chain stitches as needed to ensure the decorative band fits around the entire head.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1 Sew the bottom part of the head to the top part, with the right sides facing out and the wrong sides hidden inside.
- **2** Attach the decorative band above the ruffle edging.
- **3** Sew the tentacles to the bottom part of the head.
- 4 Add a smile and eyespots.
