TERMINOLOGY AND ABBREVIATIONS

COOKIE BOX PATTERNS ADHERE TO US CROCHET TERMINOLOGY:

SC: SINGLE CROCHET

INC: INCREASE

DEC: DECREASE

SL ST: SLIP STITCH

CH: CHAIN

HDC: HALF DOUBLE CROCHET

DC: DOUBLE CROCHET

This project is crocheted in continuous rounds, and we use «row» and «round» interchangeably.

READING THE PATTERN

ROW 4: [2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)

ROUND 4

indicates the row or round number

[2 SC, INC]

a sequence consisting of 2 single crochet stitches followed by an increase

X 6

the amount of times you need to repeat the sequence in the row or round

(24)

the total number of stitches you should have when you finish the row or round.

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DEPENDING ON THE PIECE YOU'RE WORKING ON, YOU WILL NEED TO USE ONE OF THESE METHODS TO FINISH IT OFF:

♥ **Invisible Fasten-Off:**

Pull the yarn tail through the last stitch. Use a tapestry needle to thread the tail, then pass it under the stitch after the next one. Guide the needle between the "V" of the stitch you just came from, from top to bottom, and out the other side. Pull the tail so the new stitch matches the others in size. Lastly, weave the needle under the nearby horizontal bar for added security.

♥ **Fasten-off:**

Slide the needle under the front loop of each of the six stitches, one by one, from the inside to the outside, then pull on the yarn tail to tighten the hole in the middle. Hide the yarn tail and cut off the excess yarn.

♥ **Crochet Edges Together:**

Join the sides together. Align the first and last stitches of the round. Insert your hook through both stitches and make a single crochet stitch. Continue crocheting through both sides of the round. If it's easier, start with the first and second-to-last stitches instead.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

TO COMPLETE YOUR PLUSHIE, YOU WILL NEED TO USE THE FOLLOWING SEWING TECHNIQUES:

- ♥ Attach one 3D piece to another 3D piece.
- ♥ Join a flat piece to another flat piece.
- ♥ Attach a flat piece onto a 3D piece.

PEARL

With pink yarn

Magic ring

- ROUND 1:** 6 SC (6)
- ROUND 2:** 6 INC (12)
- ROUND 3:** [SC, INC] X 6 (18)
- ROUND 4:** [2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)
- ROUND 5:** 24 SC (24)
- ROUND 6** [3 SC, INC] X 6 (30)
- ROUND 7** [3 SC, DEC] X 6 (24)
- ROUND 8:** 24 SC (24)
- ROUND 9:** [2 SC, DEC] X 6 (18)

Insert Eyes between rounds 5 and 6, 4 stitches apart.

- ROUND 10:** [SC, DEC] X 6 (12)

Add Stuffing

- ROUND 11:** 6 DEC (6)

♥ Fasten off.

SHELL

Make two identical shell halves one at a time. Each half has an outer part using blue yarn and an inner part using white yarn. Crochet each part separately and then join them together by crocheting all around with the blue yarn.

SHELL - OUTER PART

With blue yarn, do not cut the working yarn after completing all the rounds for the outer part. You will need to use this blue yarn to crochet the outer and inner parts of the half of the shell together.

Magic ring

- ROUND 1:** 6 SC (6)
- ROUND 2:** 6 INC (12) →

ROUND 3:	[SC, INC] X 6 (18)
ROUND 4:	[2 SC, INC] X 6 (24)
ROUND 5:	[3 SC, INC] X 6 (30)
ROUND 6	[4 SC, INC] X 6 (36)
ROUND 7	[5 SC, INC] X 6 (42)
ROUND 8:	42 SC (42)

SHELL - INNER PART

With white yarn.

Magic Ring

ROUND 1:	7 SC (7)
ROUND 2:	7 INC (14)
ROUND 3:	[SC, INC] X 7 (21)
ROUND 4:	[2 SC, INC] X 7 (28)
ROUND 5:	[3 SC, INC] X 7 (35)
ROUND 6	[4 SC, INC] X 7 (42)

♥ Invisible fasten off.

JOIN THE OUTER AND INNER SHELL PARTS BY CROCHETING THEM TOGETHER

Align the outer and inner parts of the shell, ensuring the right sides are facing outward.

Using the blue yarn still attached to the outer part, crochet the two pieces together with 42 single crochets. This seamlessly combines the parts.

Before completing the final stitches to close off the piece, add stuffing to ensure the shape is fully and evenly filled.

After finishing the first half of the shell, repeat all steps to create the second identical half."

Adding Ruffle Edging to the Shell's Halves:

On the edge with 42 stitches, pick any 21 consecutive stitches. In each stitch of the 21 stitches, crochet 2 half double crochets with a chain stitch after each to create ruffles.

Tip: Position the invisible fasten-offs in the center of the unused stitches. This placement will help hide them when you add the tail. Repeat this process on both halves.

TAIL

ROUND 1: Start by making a chain of 2 (ch 2) in the first stitch, then work 6 half double crochets (hdc) through both halves of the shell (total of 7 stitches).

- ♥ Preparing the Yarn: Begin with a new strand of blue yarn by making a slipknot.
- ♥ Aligning the Shell Halves: Place the two halves of the shell together, ensuring the edges align neatly. Identify the 21 stitches on the edge without the ruffle edging.
- ♥ Positioning for Crochet: Focus on the middle 7 of these stitches. This will position the tail centrally, leaving 7 unworked stitches on each side between the tail and the ruffle edges.
- ♥ Joining the Halves: Crochet through both layers along these middle 7 stitches

Tip: Complete each half double crochet (hdc) with a chain stitch (ch) to enhance the visibility of the ruffle on the edge.

ROUND 2: Begin this row by making attaching new strand of white yarn. Make a chain of 3 (ch3) in the first stitch. Then, work 2 half double crochets (hdc) into each of the next 6 stitches, resulting in a total of 13 stitches for the row
